TEXAS INVITATIONAL OPERATING RULES

- 1. <u>TI is an "invitational"</u>. Participation is not an entitlement. Discretion is used when arranging the driver roster, regardless of whether a vehicle can pass technical requirements. Once a driver returns a tech sheet and they are selected, an invitation will be sent to them via email.
- 2. <u>Failure to Grid Timely.</u> Drivers will have a reasonable time (example: 15 minutes) between heats. TI staff has the absolute authority to disqualify drivers. Grid calls will be announced over the public announcement system. If a driver misses a grid call the TI staff will disqualify them. This means a spark plug change, chute repacking, refueling, cooling, tuning adjustments, and so on must be done in the pits between heats. If you show up to the grid late, you will be disqualified.
- 3. <u>Failure to Stage Timely</u>. Once you are in the staging lanes, you will be expected to move forward to run your pairing when it is your turn. Failure to do so will result in disqualification.
- 4. <u>Support Vehicles</u>. No support vehicles will be allowed in the staging lanes. Perform all icing, mechanical work, and so on exclusively in the pits.
- 5. <u>Media</u>. With the exception of sponsors and approved publications, no media will be allowed outside of the pits and grandstand area.
- 6. <u>Registration and Inspection</u>. The local police department and the TI staff will spot check all drivers for valid registration and inspection stickers (for compliance with tech requirements).
- 7. MPH Indexing. King of the Street and 6 Speed Challenges will be arranged similar to a NHRA Pro Ladder. Ladder positions will be slotted based on MPH, which will be recorded with our speed trap system during qualifying heats. There will be a qualifying heat
- 8. Communication. During the event, do not contact the persons operating TI for personal favors.

TEXAS INVITATIONAL DEADLINES & SCHEDULE

Deadlines

- 1. All sponsor payments must be complete by December 28th, 2012.
- 2. All driver tech forms must be completely filled out and emailed back to info@texasspeedsyndicate.com before February 1st, 2013.
- 3. All driver payments must be complete by March 1st, 2013.

Schedule

- 1. <u>Friday Night</u>. Group dinner, usually around 7:01pm. Social hour at the host hotel bar, usually around 9pm. Time will be announced on Texas Speed Syndicate Facebook page and forum at TexasSpeedSyndicate.com.
- 2. <u>Saturday</u>. Gates open at the airfield at 10am. 10:30am Driver's Meeting. 11 12 noon Open Session. 1pm Grudge Match Heat 1. 2pm Grudge Match Heat 2. 3pm Grudge Match Heat 3. 4pm close.
- 3. <u>Sunday</u>. Gates open at 8am. 8:30am Driver's Meeting. 9am Qualifying Heat (this where we log your MPH for indexing classes). 10am KOTS starts. 12 noon break. 3pm 6 Speed Challenge starts. 6pm close.
- 4. <u>Changes</u>. Any changes to the schedule above will be posted on the Texas Speed Syndicate Facebook page and forum at TexasSpeedSyndicate.com.

TEXAS INVITATIONAL GENERAL RULES

- 1. No pets allowed.
- 2. No cooking equipment allowed.
- 3. No consumption of alcohol allowed (*Police will eject anyone consuming alcohol*)
- 4. No overnight camping permitted.
- 5. Dispose of all trash and effluents in the receptacles provided at the Event. Do not dispose of any trash or effluent in the grassy area surrounding the Parking area or the Parking area itself.
- 6. Park trucks and trailers on the grass. Operate your vehicles at crawl speed in the pit area. Do not use the pit area for vehicle testing or tuning requiring movement of a motor vehicle. For example, (a) no burnouts (b) no tuning requiring movement of the vehicle (c) no testing requiring movement of the vehicle and (d) no engine revving.
- 7. Guests park their vehicles on the north side of the airfield hanger, not in the pit area.
- 8. Always wear a helmet when operating your vehicle.
- 9. If your vehicle becomes in operable or loses any effluent, stop your vehicle as safely and quickly as

possible so our clean up crew can assess the situation. Do not change lanes.

- 10. All drivers and spectators must sign both waivers before entering the premises. The parents/guardians of any minors must sign a separate waiver on behalf of their minor guests.
- 11. This event is not open to the public at large.
- 12. Drivers, their guest(s), and Volunteers will be given a wristband upon entering the event premises. All persons entering the event premises must wear and agree to wear a wristband on their right wrist at all times while present at the Event Location.
- 13. All vehicles must display their assigned number on each side of their vehicle. Numbers should be at least 8 inches tall.
- 14. It is your responsibility to keep your personal items secure all times and your vehicle locked at all times.
